Minutes of meeting of Special Task Force held on 27 July 2022 at 11:30 AM under the Chairmanship of Sh. Sanjeev Kaushal, IAS, Chief Secretary, Haryana to review preparedness for implementation of Single Use Plastic (SUP) bans.

List of participants is attached at Annexure-I.

2. Director, Urban Local Bodies Department briefed about the amendment issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) in Plastic Waste Management Rules 2016 vide notification vide G.S.R 571(E) dated 12th August 2021 to ban Single Use Plastic items.
3. Further, it was apprised that Special Task Force for State of Haryana was constituted on 08 June 2021. The City Level Task Forces under the Chairmanship of Commissioners, Municipal Corporations (for million plus cities) and District Level Task Force under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioners (For cities other than million plus cities) was also constituted by State of Haryana vide Notification No. 08/05.2022-1C-II dated 10 February 2022. ULB Department has also prepared a Comprehensive Action Plan for implementation of provisions of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 and elimination of Single Use Plastic (SUP) in the State in consultation with stakeholder Departments and shared with MoEF&CC and all stakeholder departments on 21 April 2022. After that the agenda items were taken up and discussed in detail as under:-

Agenda item no. 1:- Plastic Waste Management Rules Amendments-2021

Director, ULB apprised that compliance with the directions issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), amendments were made in Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 vide notification dated 12th August 2021 to ban Single Use Plastic items as given below :-

- The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic, including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1 July 2022:
- Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration;
- Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.
- Thickness of Plastic carry bags increased to 120 microns w.e.f. 31 December 2022.
- Haryana State also issued the amendments in notification 20th August 2013 regarding ban on Single Use Plastic vide notification vide No. 08/20/2021-1C-II dated 25.02.2022.

Chief Secretary, Haryana took note of the matter and issued necessary directions for strict compliance.

Agenda item no. 2:- Activities & Awareness Campaign on Single Use Plastic ban to be done by City/District level task forces:-

DULB informed that the City/District Level Task Forces to take following action for banning of SUP Items and their alternatives:-

- Field publicity activities through setting up hoardings and displays at important public places, community assembly points, tourist spots, religious places, bus terminals etc.
- Sensitisation campaigns at market places, shopping malls, hotels, road side eateries and take-aways.
- Videos/jingles on FM/Radio
- Celebrity endorsements
- Social media campaign
- Regular newspaper advertisements on banned SUP items and alternatives
- Sensitization workshops with stakeholders/industry
- Implementation of Comprehensive Action Plan (CAP) as per timelines

Chief Secretary, Haryana took note of the matter and observed as under:-

- i. Chairmen of Task Forces were advised to increase the IEC activities for the awareness of general public. Public should be aware of penalty provisions as well as the harmful effects of single use plastic.
- ii. Sensitisation campaigns should be held at market places, malls, etc.
- iii. Meeting with shop keeper associations may also be called for the awareness of SUP bans.
- iv. Raids on manufactures, larger scale traders should also be conducted.
- v. Data of number of manufacturing units closed may also be prepared to ascertain the effectiveness of ban.
- vi. Promotion of use of alternatives, i.e., jute bags, bamboos, beeswax clothes etc., instead of prohibited SUP items.

Agenda item no. 3:- Detail of Action Taken By ULBs regarding ban on SUP:-

DULB apprised that the total 3904 challans were issued to the defaulters and penalty amounting to Rs. 43,20,250/- was levied from 1 July 2022 to 25 July 2022. Jhajjar, Sirsa, Panipat, Fatehabad and Mohindergarh districts issued lowest numbers of challans between this period.

CS, Haryana desired that all Task Forces should significantly increase the numbers of challans. CS, Haryana also suggested to use the SUP Compliance Monitoring Portal (mobile app) developed by CPCB for issuing challans.

Agenda item no. 4:- Indicative Action Plan for Elimination of Identified Single Use Plastics:-

In the meeting, comprehensive action plan (CAP) and activities required to be done at the State level were also discussed. The details are as under:-
