### THE QUORUM WAS COMPLETE.

At the outset, the Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members, to the 24th meeting of the Academic Council. The Vice-Chancellor introduced the newly appointed Director General Higher Education nominee Smt. Sangeeta Sapra and Dr. Jagbir singh, Prof. B.B. Goyal, Prof. Shalini and Dr. Sukhdeep Singh as other members to the August House. All the members have also congratulated them on being nominated to the Academic Council of BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan.

She informed the house that for the academic growth, various academic activities like webinars, seminars, workshops, conferences and faculty development programmes are being organized by different teaching departments. The University has established the National Education Policy Cell for implementing the NEP in BPS Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, Khanpur Kalan in a time bound manner. For the said purpose, an awareness programme for the entire faculty has also been conducted by the university.

She added that NAAC accreditation shall be her focal agenda. The Vice-Chancellor also added that as per statutory provision, an academic planning board has been constituted with the due approval of the Hon'ble Governor-Chancellor, BPS Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, Khanpur Kalan. To speed up the task of NAAC accreditation, frequent meetings with the Deans and Chairpersons are being convened by the Vice-Chancellor. Thereafter, she asked the Registrar to take up the agenda items.

Before taking up the agenda items, the Registrar apprized the August House that co-incidentally, this is the first Academic Council meeting after joining of present regular Vice-Chancellor and Registrar. All the members have also congratulated them for the same.
