### **6- Examination and Evaluation:**

6.1 Final examination will consist of one theory paper and one practical cum viva voce examination of 100 marks each.

6.2 Theory paper is to be set by the course coordinator and practical cum viva voce examination shall be conducted by coordinator in presence of teachers of the department. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English

6.4: Candidate has to separately secure 50% marks in theory and practical examination.

6.5: Every successful candidate shall be granted a certificate & detailed mark sheet.
