Reservation as per Govt. Norms will be applicable.

<u>STIPEND:-</u> Rate of stipend payable to apprentices per month shall be as prescribed under Apprentices Act, 1961/1973, Apprentices Rules 1992/2019 as amended from time to time.

For Graduate and Technician Apprentice, the stipend will be paid in two parts, Rs. 4500 for Graduate Apprentice and Rs. 4000 for Technician Apprentice will be paid by the Board of Apprenticeship Training (BOAT) directly in their bank accounts and the remaining amount by BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan, Sonipat. It is essential that the candidates have an Adhaar seeded bank account that is enabled for Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) for receiving the Government's share of stipend from BOAT.

However, the above shall be subject to change as per guidelines and advice from Government/Board of Apprenticeship Training/National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) or any such body stipulated by the Act/Rules for issuing guidelines regarding Apprenticeship, from time to time.

### Prescribed Qualification/Eligibility Criteria:

3 years regular full time diploma in respective trade.

- 1. Diploma under recognized Institute/University lateral entry scheme (Class XII/ITI) admitted in the second year of Diploma course shall also be considered eligible subject to meeting prescribed percentage of marks based on aggregate of all semesters in the diploma course.
- The candidates who have undergone Apprenticeship earlier or pursuing Apprenticeship
  Training in an Industry as per the Apprenticeship Act, 1961/1973/1992 as amended from
  time to time or job experience for a period of 1 year or more after attainment of the
  qualification are Not eligible.
- 3. Candidates applying under NATS who have completed three years as on 30.09.2025 in relevant discipline after acquiring the prescribed qualification as per the last semester/year marksheet shall NOT BE ELIGIBLE for engagement as apprentices.
- 4. Candidates possessing higher professional qualifications such as B.E or equivalent, MBA or equivalent or MCA/CA/ICWA, LLB or any such equivalent or pursuing higher qualification and having completed the same on or before joining the apprenticeship training shall NOT be considered eligible. A declaration from the candidate in this regard shall be obtained at the time of joining. Suppression of information regarding possession or pursuing higher qualification shall render a candidate ineligible for consideration at any stage of selection/termination or any time during period of training.

<u>Age:-</u> Minimum 18 years and Maximum 24 years as on 30.09.2025 (Relaxation as per Govt. Norms).

#### **Period of Apprenticeship Training = 12 Months**

# **Selection Methodology:**

- 1. Candidates registered on NAPS/NATS portal, and applying against the notification shall be considered for selection. There will be no written Test/Interview.
- 2. Merit list of all the candidates who have applied against a respective post in the portal and meeting the eligibility criteria shall be prepared based on the percentage of marks secured in the prescribed qualification for the post. In case of two candidates securing same percentage of marks, the candidate with earlier date of birth (older in age) shall be considered. In case of same date of birth, candidates having a higher percentage marks in matriculation shall be considered.

# **General Instructions:**

- 1. Candidates are advised to register as Graduate/Technician/Trade apprentice online in the following portals under the respective State as per their Trades below:
  - a) Technician Apprentice Diploma at NATS portal (https://nats.education.gov.in/student\_register.php)
- Before applying against an opportunity, candidate MUST ensure that their profile (Personal Details, Educational Details, Category etc.) along with aggregate percentage are appearing correctly in the portal. In case of any corrections, candidates are required to contact NAPS/NATS office. The responsibility to maintain correct details in their profile solely lies with the candidate.
- 3. Once registered, candidate needs to LOGIN to the respective NATS/NAPS portal using their User ID/Email ID and APPLY for the apprenticeship Openings/ Opportunities with the Establishment ID of Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, Khanpur Kalan, Sonipat.

- 4. Candidates not fulfilling the eligibility criteria and other terms & conditions of the advertisement will be liable for rejection.
- 5. The candidature of the applicant would be provisional and subject to subsequent verification of certificates and testimonials. In case, it is detected at any stage of engagement or thereafter, that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility norms and/or that he/she has furnished any incorrect/doctored/false information/certificate/documents or has suppressed any material fact(s), his/her candidature will stand cancelled. If any of these shortcomings is/are detected even after engagement, his/her engagement is liable to be terminated.
- 6. The decision of the University will be final and binding on all candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, mode of selection, cancellation of the selection process either in part or full, etc. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Filling up of the seats is solely at the discretion of the University based on suitability of candidates and no claim will arise for engagement, if some of these seats are not filled due to unsuitability/insufficient number of candidates.

- 7. Applications/Registration which are incomplete or are received in any other mode/form, or not fulfilling the eligibility criteria and/or those received after the last date of applying shall not be considered "Eligible" and treated as "Rejected". Canvassing of any kind shall disqualify the candidate.
- 8. The period of Apprenticeship Training is 12 months for all disciplines. Upon completion of the apprenticeship period, the University shall have NO obligation to offer employment to such apprentices NOR can an Apprentice claim right for employment on the grounds of completion of Apprenticeship.

- 1. Candidates meeting the prescribed eligibility criteria may apply online through the NAPS/NATS portal from 28 Oct. 2025 to 03 Nov. 2025. Candidate to ensure that they have successfully applied for the relevant opportunity through respective NAPS/NATS portal.
