Grant of extended permission to Shri Maru Singh Memorial Institute of Ayurveda, B.P.S. Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, VPO-Khanpur Kalan, Distt. Sonipat-131305, Haryana (Inst. ID-AYU0037) with an intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 1st renewal of permission in 02 PG courses with 08 Seats in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana - 04 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa- 04 seats course for the academic session 2025-26, under section 29 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 25.09.2025 -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) This is with reference to an appeal vide ref. no. Inst. /Ayu/25/252 dated 25.09.2025 submitted by you to the Commission against the order passed by the President, MARBISM vide letter of even no. dated 01.07.2025 and 08.08.2025 with regard to Seat Reduction in the department of **Dravyaguna Vigyana** for the Academic year 2025-26.
- 2) In view of the above, the Chairman, NCISM decided to consider the submission made by you against the impugned order dated 01.07.2025 and 08.08.2025 passed by the MARBISM.
- 3) Further, a letter vide Ref. no. 51-76/2025-26/Comm. Appeal/College (Ayu.) dated 26.09.2025 has been received from the Secretary, NCISM directing the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to grant permission to Shri Maru Singh Memorial Institute of Ayurveda, B.P.S. Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, VPO-Khanpur Kalan, Distt. Sonipat-131305, Haryana (Inst. ID-AYU0037) for intake capacity with 04 Seats in the department of Dravyaguna Vigyana for the academic session 2025-26 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 as per the concerned Act and Regulations.

"DECISION"

- 4) Therefore, in view of above, Shri Maru Singh Memorial Institute of Ayurveda, B.P.S. Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, VPO-Khanpur Kalan, Distt. Sonipat-131305, Haryana (Inst. ID-AYU0037) is hereby granted with :-
 - a) Extended Permission in UG (BAMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 and;
 - b) 1st renewal of permission in 02 PG courses with 08 Seats in the subject namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana - 04 seats (ii) Kayachikitsa- 04 seats course for the academic session 2025-2026 in accordance with Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda Regulation, 2024;
- 5) The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
 - (i) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 1st renewal of permission in 02 PG courses with 08 Seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

- 6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
- 7) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) **Compliance report of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the implementation letters vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 and 06.09.2024 issued by the board.**
- 10) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-27 :-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirement of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standard of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
- 11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.






