In addition, candidates must complete the online registration, fill out the application form, upload the requisite documents, and pay the prescribed registration fee through the University admission portal. If any seats remain vacant under TFW/EWS after the scheduled counseling, eligible candidates may submit their applications to the concerned department on or before 11.08.2026. (ii) On-the-spot admission to B.Tech. and B.Tech. (LEET) programmes shall be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis, without any reservation, from 11.08.2026 (10:00 a.m. onwards) up to the last cut-off date of admission, as per the HSTES Key Dates. (iii) Candidates should fill JEE rank in any other information column of application form and attached the copy of JEE score card. iv) Candidates shall be required to remain physically present and mark their attendance separately in the concerned department for B.Tech. and B.Tech. (LEET) admissions. v) Admissions to all programmes of B.Tech shall be made on the basis of the merit of JEE (Main) rank. However, If seat(s) is/are still remain vacant; admissions shall be made on the basis of the merit of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination i.e 10+2 as per HSTES guidelines.

- Candidates must read the HSTES Admission Brochure 2026–27 carefully to ensure that they fulfil the prescribed eligibility conditions.

- 2) Candidates will not be allowed to participate in the Institute-Level Physical Counselling without submitting the prescribed application form available on the University website (www.bpsmv.ac.in) within stipulated time. The duly filled application form, along with the required documents and the prescribed application fee of Rs. 500/- (Rs.125/- for SC/BC/PWBD category), must be submitted at the time of registration.
- 3) Admissions shall be carried out strictly in accordance with the guidelines issued by HSTES.
- 4) Selected candidates shall report to the concerned department(s) with all original documents, two sets of self-attested photocopies of the documents, and the requisite admission fee of Rs. 24,575/- for on-the-spot confirmation of admission. The payment shall be made through online mode.
