Guidelines for the participants:

1. Projects should be original and based on new/innovative ideas and must have undergone some exploration and ground work to prove its feasibility and show impact.
2. The projects are invited in six categories/areas –
 - a) Agriculture,
 - b) Basic Sciences,
 - c) Engineering & Technology,
 - d) Health Sciences and Allied Subjects, Pharmacy, Nutrition, etc.
 - e) Social Sciences, Humanities, Commerce and Law,
 - f) Interdisciplinary Research.
3. In case of a group project, only three members (the principal investigator and two major contributors) are allowed to participate. But, only one member will be allowed for presentation. The group is to inform in advance about the Lead Presenter.
4. Registration is compulsory for all participants.
5. The projects can be presented in the form of live demonstrations/models/posters/podium (oral) presentation in any aforementioned areas/fields.
6. Total time allowed for oral/podium presentation is 10 minutes. Seven minutes for presentation and three minutes for question-answer.
7. Certificates of participation will be given to all the participants and the winners will be provided with rewards.
8. Students need to prepare either a poster or a PowerPoint presentation. There will only be one round in which the student will present their idea through either a poster or a PowerPoint presentation. The specifications for the presentation are as follows:
 - a) The dimensions of the poster should be 1m x 1m (Length x Width).
 - b) The poster should not contain any identification marks such as the name of the student/presenter, affiliating institutions, names of supervisors/mentors etc.
 - c) The poster should clearly mention the problem statement, objectives, methodology employed, and a brief summary of major findings.
9. All the students must follow the rules and guidelines. Any student or group found failing to do so shall be disqualified.
10. The decision of judges will be final and binding on all participants.

Avoid:

- ✗ Long paragraphs
- ✗ Decorative images
- ✗ Excessive background graphics
